## RSVP & The Volunteer Center, RSVP Addison County, and Green Mountain Foster Grandparent Program Makes a Difference in 2021-2022



685 Older Vermonters participated in Bone Builder exercise classes offered at 41 different sites throughout Rutland & Addison County provided by 202 volunteer instructors with a total of 45 classes running twice a week the total amount of volunteer hours contributed equals 28,493 hours

**576 AmeriCorps Seniors Volunteers selflessly donated 71,635 hours of their time! Our Volunteer Center had 94 volunteers that donated 1,386 hours of their time!**



95 volunteer contributed 25,867 hours
