When can I contact One-2-One?
Office hours are Monday - Friday 8 AM - 2 P.M.

## Who is eligible for One-2-One?

Caring and compassionate volunteers provide FREE rides to eligible individuals for essential transportation which includes medical and dental appointments, well being and personal care appointments.
